PINOT NOIR

Glass Price (125ml) | Bottle Price

Thorne & Daughters "Copper Pot", Western Cape 2024

£15.00 | £70.00

A perfumed nose showing mulberries, cranberries, rosewater, and fine herbal tones. Tannins are fine while the palate is rich and complex, balancing savoury notes of wood spice mixed with plums, red currants and blood orange.

Tesselaarsdal, Upper Hemel-en-Aarde 2023

£29.00 | £140.00

Fabulously aromatic. Notes of Morello cherry, hints of strawberry. Plent of red fruit layered with exotic spice. On the palate - still completely savoury. Juiciness held in check by almost evanescent tannin. Supple and subtle and satin-like on the finish.

Restless River Le Luc, Hemel-en-Aarde 2022

£35.00 | £150.00

Spicy and exotic. Layered with notes of red fruit, Christmas cake, moss and undergrowth and held together by an overwhelming sense of red cherry. Lovely intensity on the palate. Texture, a kind of weightless weight and a savoury depth to the finish.

MERLOT

Shannon Mount Bullet, Elgin 2021

£25.00 | £115.00

Leading with a fragrance of ripe red fruits - plums and dark cherries, with earthy complexity and yet still expressing minerality. Savoury and fresh, with a well-integrated ripe and seductive tannins.

RED BLEND

Glass Price (125ml) | Bottle Price

Spice Route "Chakalaka", Swartlandh 2022

£15.00 | £75.00

Intense cerise red, with aromas of blackcurrant, rosemary and savoury spices on the nose. It is medium-bodied with well-structured tannins and flavours of spiced plums on the finish. The name "Chakalaka" symbolises the coming together of different elements to create a truly memorable experience.

Swerwer Red Blend, Swartland 2022

£18.00 | £79.00

Gentle and delicate aromas of rose petals alongside fresh berries and fragrant fynbos. The palate reveals juicy red and dark berry flavours, enriching hints of earthy pomegranate and black tea.

Ahrens Black, Swartland 2021

£22.00 | £106.00

Extraordinarily compact. Notes of cassis, black fruit, dark chocolate layered with the faintest whiff of lifted raspberry. So much juice and viscosity compressed into a single sip, the finest of tannins fantailing through the finish.

PINOTAGE

Glass Price (125ml) | Bottle Price

Spice Route, Swartland, 2024

£15.00 | £65.00

Ruby red exuberance. Aromas of ripe cherries, blackberries and plum are framed by spicier notes of clove and nutmeg. The palate is full bodied with naturally firm tannins, a juicy core of blackberry fruit, and well-integrated oak.

Scions of Sinai Feniks, Stellenbosch 2024

£24.00 | £119.00

A fabulous expression of Pinotage: pure, floral, elegant and complex. The palate is medium-bodied with slightly chalky tannins. Linear, fresh, tensile and persistent, it closes with a hint of cracked black pepper on the long finish.

SHIRAZ

Glass Price (125ml) | Bottle Price

Fairview, Paarl, 2021

£15.00 | £75.00

Intense dark fruit aromas, hints of blackcurrant, rosemary and savoury spice. A medium-bodied wine with rich plum notes and delivering well-integrated tannins on the finish.

Swerwer, Swartland, 2022

£18.00 | £82.00

Subtle aromas of blackberries, fynbos, lavender, and pepper. The palate reveals vibrant red fruit, with crunchy tannins, bright acidity, and a long, dry finish. This elegant Shiraz, influenced by the granitic soils of Swartland, delivers earthy and cedar notes, with a well-structured mouthfeel and a fruity aftertaste.

CABERNET FRANC

Glass Price (125ml) | Bottle Price

Journeys End V Range, Stellenbosch, 2024

£15.00 | £65.00

Intense ripe cherry, savoury olive and wild fynbos characters on the nose rounded up by a sweet cinnamon spice from generous oak maturation. Great balance on the palate with coastal freshness, Mediterranean minerality and soft powdery tannins delivering a long dry finish.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Vergelegen Reserve, Stellenbosch 2022

£15.00 | £65.00

Waves of blackcurrant and ripe plums with an undertone of plush leather. Layers of perfectly managed tannins leading to an opulent and savoury finish.

Keermont, Stellenbosch 2021

£23.00 | £115.00

Bright cassis and dark fruit melding with spiced wood and a fabulous deep earthiness, meaty notes and middle eastern spice - think cloves, star anise and ras al hanout. The pallet is soft and rich, with gentle rounded tannins, dusted with cocoa and a bright strawberry and mulberry note on the finish.

BORDEAUX STYLE BLENDS

Glass Price (125ml) | Bottle Price

Boschendal Nicolas, Stellenbosch 2023

£15.00 | £65.00

A vibrant wine with smooth tannins, excellent length and timeless elegance. On the nose red cherries, fresh plums, mulberries and cassis are complemented by pencil-shavings, dark chocolate and spicy cigar box flavours. Complex and lingering.

The Last Elephant, Stellenbosch 2022

£23.00 | £109.00

An iron fist in a velvet glove. The nose is evocative, showing blackcurrants, red cherries, cedar wood, lead pencil and cigar box aromas. These develop in the glass and are joined by raspberry, black cherry, spice and a hint of gaminess. A wine that lives up to the mystical legacy of the gentle giants that once roamed the mountains of the Winelands.

Vergelegen Bordeaux Style Estate Blend, Stellenboscha 2022

£27.00 | £130.00

A classic Bordeaux style blend - Leading with intense ruby red hue and showcasing deep black cherry, opulent leather spice and red plums. Integrated tannins and a dense, almost creamy texture, finishing complex and harmonious.

Frans K Smith Red Blend, Stellenbosch, 2018

£55.00 | £250.00

Imperial opulence. Rich and ripe, but not all brocade underlying the plushness. The perfect line of red fruit, and cassis dense velvet finishing on the silkiest of tannins.

CAP CLASSIQUE

Glass Price (125ml) | Bottle Price

Spier Brut, Stellenbosch, 2023

£15.00 | £55.00

Fine exuberant mousse leading easily to a creamy and very accessible palate. Notes of red fruit, hints of lemongrass and whiffs of lime. On the palate - generous and yet supple. A really caressing sip that stays with you for a very long time.

Spier Rosé Brut, Stellenbosch 2023

£15.00 | £55.00

Luminous salmon pink, almost incandescent. Finely managed mousse, plenty of bubble but creamy and enticing. On the palate, loads of red fruit. Notes of cherry and strawberry with just a ghost of brioche adding complexity to the finish.

Boschendal Vintage Cuvée, Elgin 2017

£18.00 | £80.00

Fresh green apple and hints of citrus supported by discreet almond biscotti and brioche typical of classic bottle fermented sparkling wine style. Extended lees contact gives a full and creamy mouthfeel with elegant minerality, good balance and a seamless finish.

Black Elephant Zero Dosage, Elgin NV

£20.00 | £95.00

Fine creamy mousse, fresh lime citrus aromas, whiffs of pomelo, delicate hints of wet stone. Pure and linear with a zesty freshness that carries the length of the palate and adds an almost saline note to the finish.

Spier Prestige, Elgin 2018

£23.00 | £120.00

Delicate creamy mousse. Fabulously rich aromatics, notes of baked brioche, hints of patisserie. Plush and opulent yet somehow still fresh and seductive. Generous and persistent.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Glass Price (125ml) | Bottle Price

Mother Rock Empire of Dirt Sauvignon Blanc, Swartland, 2024

£15.00 | £60.00

A finely structured Sauvignon Blanc, driven by precise citrus acidity, layered with subtle herbaceous notes and a mineral edge. A lovely rounded and lingering finish on the palate.

Jasper Raats Driefontein, Stellenbosch, 2023

£16.00 | £75.00

Fresh minerality, with a hint of honey and fresh lemon rind. Undertones of orange marmalade and green apple finishing with a vibrancy that coats the palate.

Gabrielskloof "Amphora", Walker Bay, 2024

£17.00 | £80.00

An atypical Sauvignon Blanc fermented and aged in clay amphorae, this wine is textured and complex with aromas of white pear and yellow peach, as well as hints of blackcurrant leaf and smoke on the nose. The palate is silky and layered with mouth-watering acidity and notes of grapefruit rind, salted almond and wet stone.

Storm Wild Air, Hemel-en-Aarde, 2023

£19.00 | £90.00

Wild Air is a brilliant, zippy, concentrated Sauvignon Blanc with good textural depth to match its freshness. The clay rich soils and lashings of the icy cold Atlantic breeze are palatable in this cool climate style - saline, gooseberry and granadilla compote, finishing with a balanced acidity.

Thorne and Daughters "Snakes & Ladders", Western Cape, 2022

£20.00 | £95.00

Blackcurrants, crushed bay leaves and aromas of balanced tropical fruit tones combine to form an intensely complex nose. The palate is rich and structured with gooseberry and granadilla cut by a saline acidity. Barrel fermentation and ageing in old oak for 10 months contributes great texture to the wine.

Fryer's Cove Bamboes Bay, Bamboes Bay, 2023

£25.00 | £130.00

This wine brims with a vibrant mix of citrus and passion-fruit aromas, while wisps of fresh seaweed awaken the senses. The nose follows through on the palate with intense lime and tropical flavours, rounded off with lingering salty minerality typical of the Cape West Coast and Bamboes Bay.

CHENIN BLANC

Glass Price (125ml) | Bottle Price

Stark Conde Monk Stone, Stellenbosch 2024

£17.00 | £81.00

The nose is a complex mix of tropical notes, lime, fynbos and subtle Crème Brûlée. The palate presents a harmonious marriage of chamomile, white peach and brioche.

Ahrens Kwaarts van die Paarl, Paarl 2021

£21.00 | £100.00

Brilliant and intense fruit compote aromas. Notes of dried peach, Turkish apricot and white pear. On the palate however, a surprising linearity. Flinty and fresh with nuanced notes of ginger, lemongrass and Granny smith apple. Savoury and food friendly.

De Trafford, South Africa 2019

£22.00 | £105.00

Straw yellow colour. Peach and apricot nose with lemon, honey and floral notes. Complex, substantial palate. Fresh, elegant and restrained, but with power and length.

WHITE BLENDS

Glass Price (125ml) | Bottle Price

Ahrens Whiteblack, Swartland 2021

£22.00 | £105.00

Harmonious stone fruit. Restrained whiffs of nectarine, white peach and pear. Succulent and yet elusive with a fresh sap brightness promising a food friendly engagement. Lovely honeysuckle whiffs fantailing the finish.

Frans K Smith Bordeaux Style, Stellenbosch 2023

£55.00 | £250.00

Intense and concentrated notes of gooseberry, thatch and fresh mown hay. An almost incandescent halo of melon and herbs de provence. Super fresh, still very tight but exploding with flavour on the palate and finishing flinty and dry.

CHARDONNAY

Glass Price (125ml) | Bottle Price

De Wetshof Bon Vallon, South Arica 2024

£15.00 | £50.00

Brisk and clean freshness leading into a spectrum of classic flavours including citrus, white flowers and grilled nuts, with a nuanced minerality on the aftertaste.

Journeys End Destination, Stellenbosch 2023

£19.00 | £91.00

A complex nose of concentrated stone fruit with layers of citrus, lemongrass, tropical fruit, and hints of smoky spice arising from generous oak ageing. The ever present minerality and natural acidity ensure freshness and adds focus to a long-lasting creamy finish.

Lelie Van Saron, Upper Hemel-en-Aarde 2022

£22.00 | £106.00

The nose shows pithy grapefruit and lime peel, with limestone minerality and subtle hints of oak. The palate displays excellent varietal purity with a linear, mineral structure balanced by ripe lemon, melon and stone fruit. A long finish with lingering citrus fruit.

Tesselaarsdal, Hemel-en-Aarde Ridge 2023

£28.00 | £135.00

Crisp acidity and lean minerality underpin notes of melon and tangerine fruit and accents of lime blossom. A triumphant expression of terroir, this medium-bodied, cool climate wine is both silky and fresh and boasts a long, elegant finish.
